Saints of the Week

Tuesday: St Lawrence, (Doctor of the Church) was a Capuchin Monk of great culture. A teacher and writer of Theology he preached in many regions of Europe.

Wednesday: St Mary Magdalene was one of the few who remained with Christ during His agony on the Cross. It was to here that Our Lord first appeared after his resurrection.

Thursday: St Bridget was born in Sweden. She was a mother of eight whom she raised in a Christian manner. One daughter is St Catherine of Sweden. After her husband's death she devoted herself to a contemplative life. She founded the Brigittine Order and wrote many works on ascetical & mystical subjects.

Friday: St Sharbel Makhul was the son of a Lebanese farmer. He became a monk and had a great devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.
Saturday: St James, Apostle. He is called "the Great" because he preceded other Apostles with the same name. He was the son of Zebedee and was called by Jesus with his brother John and they along with Peter witnessed the Transfiguration and The Lord's agony in The Garden of Gethsemane. He was condemned to death by Herod Agrippa and beheaded in 44 AD, the first martyr among the Apostles.
