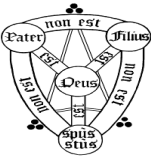

DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES 2024

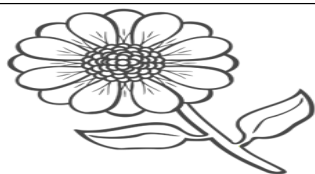
