The Word this Week– The Holy Body and the Blood of Christ—Today we look at the Covenants made with God. The Old Covenant sealed in its greatest form on Mount Sinai as we hear in the First reading when the Old Covenant had been broken beyond repair, the establishment of a New Covenant: the sacrifice and meal of this New Covenant is Calvary and the Last Supper, where Christ is both Priest and Victim and Altar. When we eat and drink this sacred meal at every Mass we are renewed in the New Covenant.
