## Saints of the Week

**St Bede** was an English Benedictine Monk 'the most observant & happiest of all monks'. His writings on scripture & Theology were full of sound doctrine and he was called 'Venerable' while still alive.

**St Philip Neri** was ordained in 1551 and founded the Congregation of the Oratory. (Cardinal Newman) and was noted as a Catechist and spiritual Guide.

**St Augustine of Canterbury** was sent by Gregory the Great to convert the English. He baptized King Ethelbert of Kent and many of his subjects. At Canterbury he erected a monastery and established his Episcopal See there. The Solemnity of Dedication celebrating the Consecration of a church. Consecration Candles (seen around such churches) will be lit during the celebration of Mass
