### SAINTS OF THE WEEK

**St Bonaventure** was born in Tuscany in 1218. After studying in Paris he taught students of the Franciscan Order of which he was Master General for 17 years. He died in 1274  
**Blessed John Sugar and Blessed Robert Grissold** were laymen who were martyred for their faith in Warwick in 1604.  
**St Kenelm** was the Prince of Mercia in the ninth century. Following his death the village of Clent in Worcestershire became the centre of his cult. He is the Diocesan Patron of Our Youth Service.  
**St Camillus de Lellis** was born in 1550. After a military career he joined a religious community and dedicated himself to the care of the sick. He was ordained priest and founded a Religious Congregation of Nurses.
