Monday: St Sharbel Makhluf the son of a Lebanese farmer. He became a monk and had great devotion to the Blessed Sacrament.

Tuesday: James, Apostle was the son of Zebedee. He was called by Jesus together with his brother John and along with Peter they witnessed the Transfiguration and the Agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. He was condemned to death by Herod Agrippa & beheaded in AD44. The first Apostle to be martyred.

Wednesday: St Joachim and St Anne were Our Blessed Mother Mary's parents. Devotion to them is an extension of the affection which Christians have always professed towards our Blessed Mother.

Thursday: Bl. Robert Sutton was born in Burton-on-Trent. He was a clergyman of the Established church but converted to Catholicism with his two brothers. They were all ordained priests. He was executed in Stafford in 1588.

Saturday: St Martha. Our Lord liked the home of Martha, Mary and their brother Lazarus. As His friends they took loving care of Him.
