SAINTS OF THE WEEK

St Lawrence Brindisi was a Capuchin monk who travelled throughout Europe preaching the Faith. He died in Portugal in 1619.

St Mary Magdalene was from the Galilean village of Magdala. According to St Mark's she was the first witness of the Resurrection, St John she anointed Jesus' feet and was the sister of Martha and Lazarus.

St Bridget was born in Sweden in 1303. She was married and had eight children but after the death of her husband she lead an ascetic life. She founded the Brigittine order in Rome and died in 1373.

St Sherbel Makhluif was the son of a Lebanese farmer. He became a monk and hermit with his devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. He was Canonized in 1977.

St James, Apostle, was from Bethsaida in Galilee. He and his brother John were the sons of Zebedee. He was martyred in 42 AD. He is venerated at his shrine in Compostella. He is the Patron Saint of Spain.

SS Joachim and Anne the parents of Mary. The names were accredited to them in the second century. They are the Patron Saints of Grandparents.
