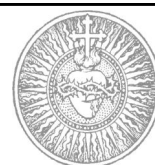

- **ST. BLAISE** was the Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. He was martyred for the faith in the early 300s. The story is told that during the persecution he was hiding in a cave when a woman brought him her young son who was choking to death on a fish bone. He cured the lad. Later when he was in prison the same lady brought him food and candles. Hence the traditional blessing on St. Blaise's day of throats with two crossed candles. The origins of Sutton Coldfield was a hunting lodge of the Earls of Warwick. In the Lodge there was a chapel dedicated to St. Blaise. In the parish we do have a road named after the him (in the Roughley area.)
