**PARISH DATA BASE**—During this difficult time of pandemic and lockdown, it has become obvious that a “Parish Data Base” is absolutely essential going forward. And by parish we obviously mean both Holy Trinity and Sacred Heart. It will enable us as a community to keep in touch with all our parishioners. All such information will be properly processed and conserved according to GDPR legislation as monitored by the Archdiocese. This data will form the initial steps of a new parish “census” which we know can only be completed when the parish returns to some form of normal activity. The format of this “census” is as designed by the Archdiocese.
