We are encouraged to make a ‘spiritual communion’ as it will strengthen our “*desire for the sacrament of the Eucharist*” (St John Paul II). Saint Teresa of Jesus wrote: “*When you do not receive communion and you do not attend Mass, you can make a “spiritual communion”, which is a most beneficial practice; by it the love of God will be greatly impressed on you.*”

How Do I Make a “Spiritual Communion”?

Alone or together with others in your household

Make the sign of the cross

You could read the Gospel of the day

Then share prayer intentions quietly or aloud

Say the Lord’s Prayer

Then make an act of spiritual communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament.

I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul.

Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You.

Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.
