PARISH NOTICE BOARD CHURCH RE- OPENS - From Monday 15th June the government is

allowing churches to open for private individual prayer. This excludes any formal summons to prayer, service, liturgy or blessing. It cannot involve the participation of any minister, nor would it permit a group of individuals to pray in common, e.g. in public recitation of the Rosary.

Instructions have been issued by the Archdiocese as to how this is to be achieved, not least of which is the completion of a very detailed risk assessment which the Archdiocese and its insurers must approve in advance. Clearly this is not going to be achieved by next Monday, but following discussions today within the parish it is hoped to re-open Holy Trinity in the week commencing 22 June for a limited time each week, say, 2 hours on each Tuesday and Thursday (from 12 noon until 2.00pm).

The church will be cleaned on Saturday 20 June at 11.00am in preparation.

Sacred Heart may open shortly thereafter subject to review of Holy Trinity experience. Fundamental to the process is that in order to open the church, even in this limited way, we will be required to have 2 or 3 volunteers on hand to supervise people's access and use of the church, and to have the church sanitised after every such opening. This will require a team of volunteers.

Volunteers should be deemed healthy and fit prior to commencement of work. At present this excludes those who are vulnerable, self-isolating or shielded. We can only re-open if we get a team of volunteers together. So please do think whether, how and when you could assist. Could you offer a couple of hours once a week to staff a 'time for private prayer'? Please let us know if you wish to be a volunteer. For reasons of health and safety, and safeguarding, I must approve each volunteer.

SACRED HEART'S PARISH — Father Cousins writes:

Friday is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, our Patronal Feast. Sadly this year there will be no festive Mass and Reception afterwards in the Hall. Make next Friday a feast day at home. Give yourself a treat of some kind. Remember we do not need church buildings, fine singing, a powerful sermon to celebrate the love of God for us in the Heart of Jesus, though they do help.

At home we can, and we should, express our love for Jesus in prayer, in the way we treat our spouse, our household and what we can do for our friends.

Secondly, again this year the church will not be open for private prayer. The Diocese has sent us four A4 pages of conditions to be fulfilled before opening the church. For instance, there must be a strict risk assessment; there must be two stewards on duty while the church is open; there must be one way of entering, another for leaving; after closing areas used for prayer must be thoroughly cleansed; and much more.

Father Michael is hoping to open Holy Trinity is a week or so time. One hears the Abbey in Erdington will be opening: but what hours? I suggest you telephone on 0121 373 0143.
