### HOLY TRINITY UPDATE ON LIGHTNING STRIKE

#### Update on Lightning Strike

This is obviously the subject of an insurance claim for which we are covered. Professionals are handling all aspects of the damage.

**Church Lighting** – As promised some further replacement parts were fitted this week. Most of the lights are now working at 100% including the sanctuary. Unfortunately there is still no light in the porch area and further parts are awaited. The lights in the choir loft are not yet functioning from their own keypad outside the choir. But they can be switched on if necessary by pressing the  $\blacktriangle$  key on the sacristy keypad. They can be turned off by pressing  $\blacktriangledown$ . Pressing “0” turns all the lights off.

**Church Sound** – Better news here. The replacement (and better!) units have been fitted and some of the unreliable elements from the past have been eliminated. Many thanks to Stuart Hawkins, our expert.

**Live Streaming** – as previously reported a new (and upgraded) camera has been fitted and today Stuart Hawkins wired in the sound from the church system. So no ‘hiss’ and other extraneous noises from our broadcasts. Operation of the camera is organised remotely on-line; the actual camera should not be touched under any circumstances.

**COVID 19**—Please be very vigilant: maintain the wearing of masks, hand sanitising & social distancing. We here at HT will continue to wear masks in church & keep our social distancing as it is for the time being. We shall review the situation during the half term break in October. Thanks for your continued support.
