SACRED HEART

ATTENDANCE AT MASS Ought we not to be returning to the actual celebration of Mass and not be satisfied with a Zoom Mass? Ought we not return to receiving the Real Body of Christ? I came across a piece in Cardinal George Pell's "Prison Journal". On the 11th November 2018 he was convicted by a court in Melbourne and sent to prison. For his safety he is put in a block for solitary confinement. On 12th November 2019 permission was given for a priest to celebrate Mass with the Cardinal attending. He writes: "It was a relief to have the Mass, to have the drought broken, if only for this occasion. For some weeks, when I obtained a text, I read it through as a 'dry' Mass, but I found this unsatisfactory; not counterfeit, but not the genuine article which must be revered. Neither do I make 'spiritual communions', whatever that means, because God is already in my heart spiritually, and I don't have the means to confect the Real Presence." As you know Cardinal Pell's conviction was overturned by the High (Supreme) Court of Australia in 2020. All seven Justices found he had been incorrectly convicted.
