Consultation on Changes to Admissions Policies for 2022/23 Academic Year

The change proposed by the Directors is to remove the *Certificate of Catholic Practice* from the oversubscription criteria for these schools. Please note that evidence of baptism will still be required in order for children to qualify as Catholic in these proposed policies. Responses to these proposals for any or all of these schools can be made in writing to the address on this letter or via email through enquiry@sjp2.net. The consultation period ends on 15th Jan. Responses to the consultation will be considered by the Board of Directors before policies are finalised.

TO STOP HOME ABORTION

The Department of Health is holding a public consultation on whether to continue the practice of allowing abortion providers to send abortion pills to women so that they can perform their own abortion at home. We need as many pro-life people as possible to complete the Department of Health’s questionnaire in order to help stop dangerous DIY abortions becoming permanent.
