

- FORTY DAYS OF LENT We have begun the forty days of Lent, a time
 of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Let us pray over chapter 58 of Isaiah:

 share your bread with the hungry, and shelter the homeless poor, to
 clothe the man you see to be naked and not turn from you own kin?"
- LENTEN FAMILY FAST DAY is next Friday 11th March. The idea is we fast on Friday.
