COVID 19 OMICRON IS HERE AND REMAINS A RISK IT IS STILL POSSIBLE TO CATCH AND SPREAD COVID-19, EVEN IF YOU ARE FULLY VACCINATED.

Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms or a positive test result should stay at home and self-isolate immediately. - ◆ As Covid 19 continues to be as virulent as last year, we must still be extra careful. Provided that there are no further government decrees, these are the guidelines which we at Holy Trinity will follow.
- ◆ Masks will be worn
- ◆ Hands will be sanitised on entry to church
- ◆ It is preferable for only those who have been double vaccinated to attend (excl. those under 16 of course).
- * We ask that you download the QR code from the internet to present at church from - **You can access your NHS COVID Pass through: The NHS App NHS.UK** A letter that you can obtain on NHS.UK or by calling 119
- ◆ All of us can play our part by understanding the situations where risks of COVID-19 infection and transmission are likely to be higher and taking action to reduce these risks.
- * Following this guidance will help you to understand situations where there is a greater risk of catching or spreading COVID-19 and the steps that you can take to stay safe and protect others. Every action you can take to help reduce the spread will help reduce pressure on the NHS during the winter months.
