SYNODAL PATHWAY

The report from the parish of our discussions, thoughts and suggestions has now been collated and synthesised. A copy has been sent to the Archdiocese's Synodal representative, Canon Paul Fitzpatrick. Copies are available on

our website <u>www.htrc.org.uk</u>. *Diocesan Discernment:* During the month of March various 'reading groups' representing every aspect of Diocesan life have been invited to gather at St Chad's Cathedral to read and discern the responses from parishes, schools and individuals, so that every response will be read several times. This process is two-fold: it will enable Archbishop Bernard Longley to produce the Diocesan response to the Synod, a 10-page document to be presented to the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. It will also provide an opportunity to feed directly into our *Diocesan Vision, Unfolding God's Plan*, and our own priorities.
