Ash Wednesday (22nd February)

Fast and Abstinence: Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat). Every person between the age of 18 and 59 (beginning of 60th year) must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. (Take no more than one full meal, which may not be eaten before noon, and which must not take more than three hours to eat. In addition one or two light collations (snacks) may be taken in order to prevent oneself from being made seriously ill, particularly if working.)
