PACT (Prison Advice and Care Trust)

is holding a roadshow on Saturday 15 July between 10am and 1.30pm in the Grimshaw Room on the St Chad's Cathedral As Catholics, why do we support prisoners and their families? A woman we helped recently, said, 'Pact is like a little light, it gives you hope.' Certainly, we are responding to Jesus' words, 'I was in prison and you came to me' - but something deeper is happening too. At the roadshow we will reflect on Catholic Social Teaching in the light of imprisonment. We will hear from people with lived experience of the criminal justice system. Prison chaplains and Pact services staff will speak about their work and the people we serve. The Welcome Directory is a small charity which supports faith communities to become places of welcome and acceptance for those leaving prison.
