In view of this, it has been decided to reinstate the Holy Water Stoops on the Font. From today water blessed at the Easter Vigil will be in them. Dipping our fingers in and signing ourselves, we ought to remind ourselves of our Baptism and that we are a child of God. Know your dignity, said St. Leo the Great.
