Saints of the Week

Monday: St Pius XI: born in Venice in 1835 was a priest and Bishop in Venice before he was elected Pontiff. He extended the practice of frequent Communion especially to children.

Tuesday Memorial of the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Wednesday: St John Wall, Priest . Martyr was from Preston but educated in France & Rome where he ioined the Friars Minor. In 1656 he came to Worcester where he served until he was martyred in 1679. Thursday: St Bartholomew, Apostle, was from Cana in Galilee. He is identified with Nathaniel and was brought to Jesus by his friend Philip. He preached the Gospel in Arabia and Armenia where he died a martyr. Saturday: Blessed Dominic Barbari, was from Viterbo in Italy. And as Passionist Priest. He taught Theology but felt called to preach to the people in England. In 1845 he received John Henry Newman into the Roman Catholic Church at Littlemore in Oxford. He also preached widely in Staffordshire around Sone and Stafford where at first he was ridiculed but gradually converted many people to the Faith.
