Monday: Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Tuesday: St John Wall, Priest and martyr was born in Preston and educated in Rome where he joined the Friars Minor. In 1656 he joined the Worcester Mission which he served until his martyrdom in 1679.

Wednesday: St Bartholomew, Apostle: was from Cana and preached the gospel in Arabia and Armenia where he was martyred.

Friday: Blessed Dominic Barberi, was a Priest in the Order of Passionists. He was sent to convert the English. He received John Henry Newman into the church and then worked tirelessly at Stone & Stafford with great success in bringing the people to God.

Saturday: Memorial of St Monica. Mother of St Augustine of Hippo.
