Monday: St Cuthbert worked as a shepherd in Northumbria until he joined the community at Melrose Abbey but later he moved to Lindisfarne. He became Bishop of Hexham in 684. He was known for his holiness and miracles. He was buried on Lindisfarne but later re-interred at Durham.
