### Saints of the week

**Monday: St Paulinus of York** was sent from Rome to assist Augustine in Canterbury later he became the first Bishop of York evangelizing the North "

**Tuesday: Bl'd William Howard**, accused of complicity in the "Popish Plot" he was imprisoned and beheaded in 1680.

**St John XXIII Pope:** set a stone for the II Vatican Council.

**Wednesday: St Wilfred** from Lindisfarne, was a Bishop of York preaching in Yorkshire, Sussex and the Isle of Wight.

**Thursday: St Edward the Confessor.** Was the penultimate Anglo Saxon King of England A man of great piety he established Westminster Abbey where his relics are buried.

**Saturday: St Teresa of the Child Jesus** (the first female Doctor of the Church) was born in Avila and became a Carmelite Sister in 1535 later reforming the Order writing outstanding works of mysticism & asceticism. Her spiritual teachings are a guide to a life of union with God.
