Tuesday: Luke, Evangelist. He was a physician from Antioch and a disciple of Paul. He was the author of the Gospel and Acts of the apostles telling of Christ's childhood and the parables of the Lost sheep and Prodigal Son.
Wednesday: Frideswide, Abbess foundress of the Benedictine convent in Oxford.
Saturday: Pope John Paul II. From Wadowice in Poland. After his election as Pope in 1978 his apostolic zeal for families, young people and the sick led him on numerous pastoral visits throughout the world.
