EFFECT OF LATEST LOCK-DOWN REGULATIONS

You will be aware by now of the second Covid 19 lockdown effective from Thursday 5 November until Wednesday 2 December. We are obliged to close our churches from Thursday 5 November. And so there will be no public liturgy from **5 November**. In consequence:

Mass will be celebrated on line each weekday at 10.00am; that is from Monday to Saturday inclusive

The vigil Mass will be celebrated on line each Saturday at 6.00pm Mass will be celebrated on line each Sunday at 11.00am.

Zoom liturgy will recommence on Sunday 8 November at 6.00pm As these masses are closed to the public they will be streamed as now; but they will also be recorded for those who like to watch at different times.

Father Michael wishes to open the church daily for private prayer So commencing on Thursday 5 November and every weekday from Monday to Saturday inclusive, Holy Trinity will be open for private prayer from 11.00am until 12 noon; and Sacred Heart on Monday to Friday from 10am to 11 am.

Neither church will be open for private prayer on Sundays.

These church openings will be managed by our stewards as they did during the earlier lockdown, to keep us safe and to comply with Track and Trace requirements.
