- **St Chad's Cathedral is the Mother Church of our Diocese.** With only a very small congregation it is deemed a 'POOR PARISH'. Designed by AW Pugin (who designed the Houses of Parliament) it was consecrated in 1841. A WW1 Heritage Fund Grant has paid for roof repairs this month but the electrics, lighting and sound system all need renewing. As a Parish we are obliged to support the Annual Collection which will be taken this weekend.
