SAINTS OF THE WEEK

St Aloysius Gonzaga (Wed. 21st June) - an Italian Jesuit who died as a result of his devoted nursing of the plague-stricken poor.

St John Fisher (Thur. 22/6) was Bishop of Rochester and his friend Thomas More wrote of him " In this realm no one man in wisdom, learning an virtue together, meet to be matched and compared with him"

St Thomas More (Thur. 22/6) was Chancellor to Henry VIII. As a family man and public servant his life was an expression of a rare synthesis of human sensitivity and Christian wisdom.

They both gave their lives in 1535 in testimony to the unity of the Church and the indissolubility of marriage.
