Saints of the Week

St Justin was a philosopher born in Samaria. A convert to Christianity, he was a passionate searcher for truth which he found in Christ. He then defended the Christian Faith with his writings, notably "Apologies" and "Dialogue." He was martyred in Rome during the reign of Marcus Aurelius.

St Charles Lwanga there was a persecution of Christians out of hatred for religion in Uganda under King Mwanga. Charles was martyred with 12 companions on 3 June 1886; others were killed later. Some of the victims, almost a hundred in all, were very young or newly baptised.

St Boniface, a Benedictine monk, was born in England. He preached in Germany and later was consecrated its first Bishop. He then was able to organise the Church in Germany. He was martyred while preaching among the Frisians.
