BAPTISM

You are asking in Baptism that Almighty God will adopt your Child as his Son or Daughter and offer His love and life to the baby. But this gift that God gives to your Child can only be understood when you show and explain this gift to your Child. No one else can do this for your Child if you neglect to do so. Priests and Teachers can help but cannot replace what is not learnt from the Parents. If Parents neglect Mass and Prayers there is no reason to hope that Children will copy anyone else.

God revealed himself to us through His Son, Jesus. Jesus reveals Himself to Children through their Parents - if at all.

Baptism is not a Naming Ceremony.

It is a Sacrament of God's love.

God loves your Child. If you love your Child you will tell it of God's love and show how you value that Love yourselves.

Baptisms take place on Sundays at 12:30 or 1:30 pm

You will be required to attend a Baptism Preparation Course before the Baptism, preferably before you book a date. These are usually on the second Sunday of the month at 3:00pm.
