## SAINTS OF THE WEEK

**St Thomas** is remembered for his doubt in Christ's resurrection although this was dispelled when Christ appeared to the Disciples again. Tradition tells us that he preached in India. He is the Patron Saint of India and Pakistan.

**St Elizabeth** was born in 1271 in France. She married the King of Portugal but after his death she established orphanages and hospitals having joined the Franciscans.

**St Modwen** was one of a group of Irish hermits who brought the Gospel to the Anglo-Saxons during the seventh century. She established a monastery at Burton -on-Trent where the Parish church is dedicated to her.
