UPDATE ON LIGHTNING STRIKE This is obviously the subject of an insurance claim for which we are covered. Professionals are handling all aspects of the damage.

CHURCH LIGHTING we are currently waiting for replacement parts which are on three week delivery. We shall continue to turn lights on manually, but unfortunately there are no lights in the porch. Some replacement parts can/will be fitted on Tuesday next which should give us some light operable from existing sacristy and porch switches.

CHURCH SOUND – Better news here. The replacement (and better!) units have been fitted and some of the unreliable elements from the past have been eliminated. Many thanks to Stuart Hawkins, our expert.

LIVE STREAMING – as previously reported this is not just dependant on our router, which has been replaced, but on its own power source. On replacing the power source on Tuesday it was discovered that the camera itself had been irreparably damaged. A new one has been ordered from Ireland and should arrive early next week. Our CCTV expert, Tom Rooker, is on standby to install. In addition our sound expert will wire in the sound from the church's own sound system into the camera which will eliminate the 'hiss' and other extraneous noises from our broadcasts.

COVID 19 Please be very vigilant: maintain the wearing of masks, hand sanitising and social distancing. We here at Holy Trinity will continue to wear masks in church and keep our social distancing as it is for the time being. We will review the situation during the half term break in October. Thanks for your continued support.
