LENTEN FAMILY FAST DAY was last Friday. Please place your offerings in the basket in porch. This year CAFOD is featuring Abdella. He lives in an extremely remote and mountainous part of Ethiopia. It takes him ten hours a day to collect water. He says his life is being wasted as he has no time for anything else. Can we go that extra mile for Abdella? £10 can buy sturdy water containers so families can store water safely, £40 can bring safe to drink water to a hard to reach school. £750 can give a community a sure water supply.
